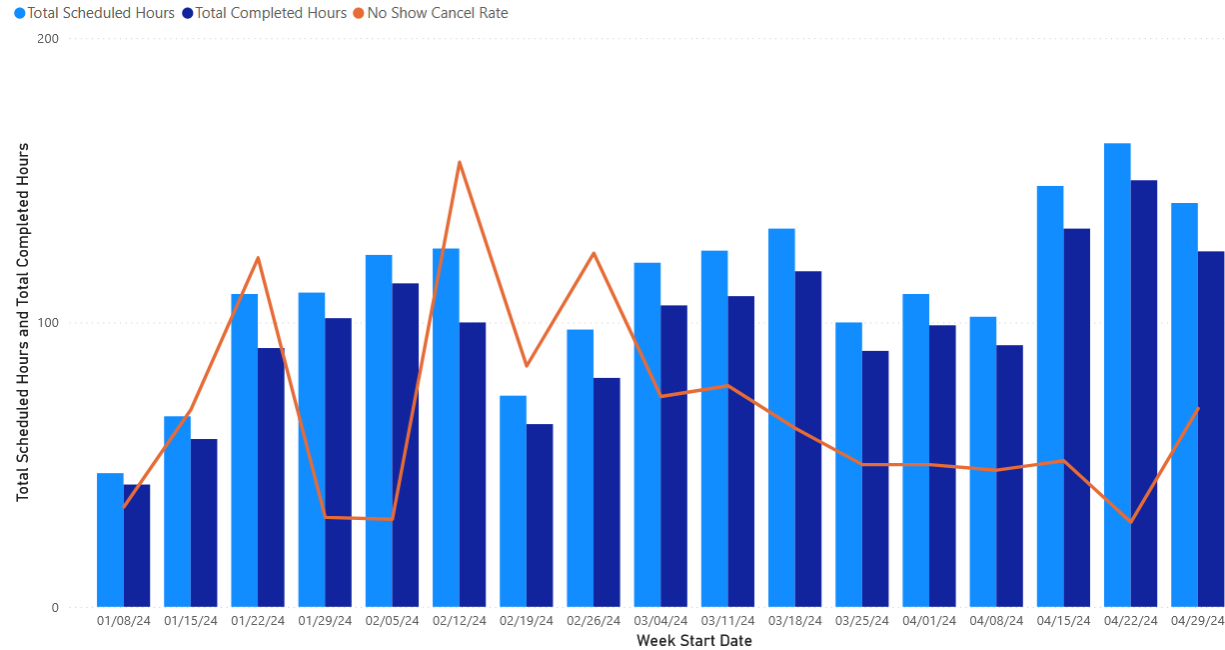

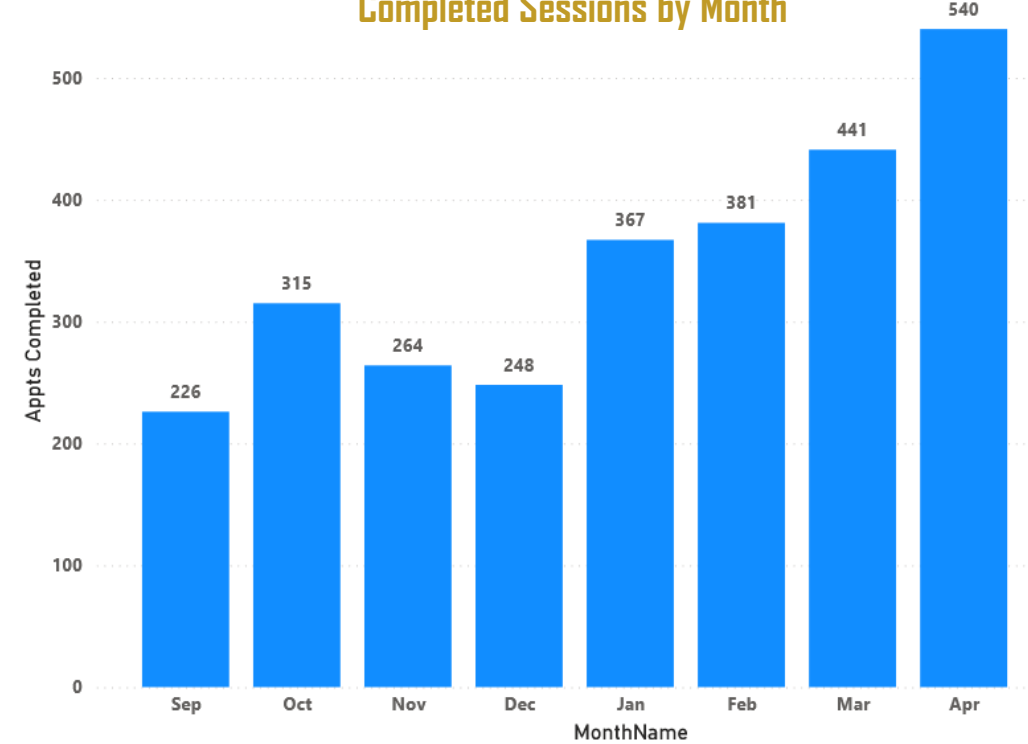

Completed Sessions by Month

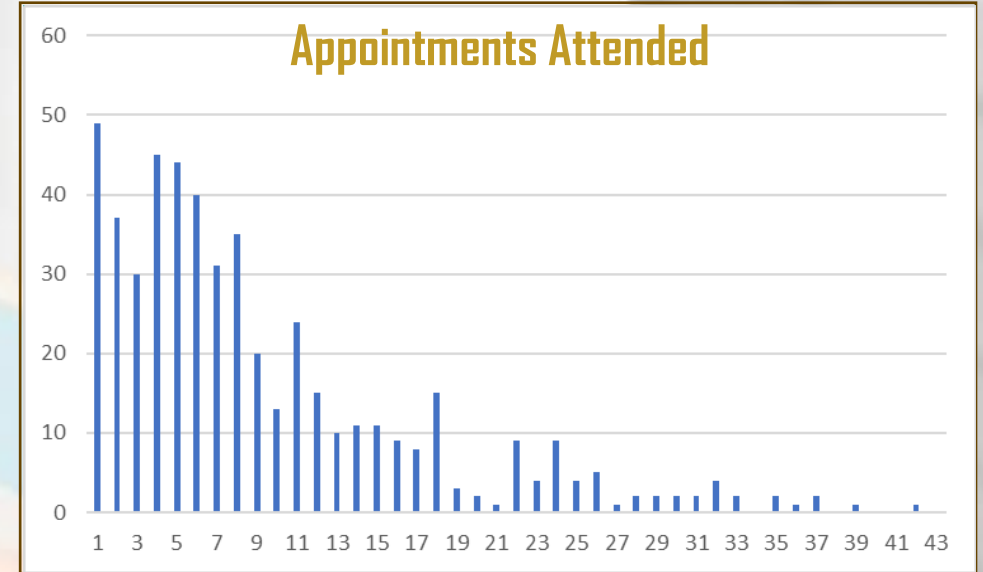
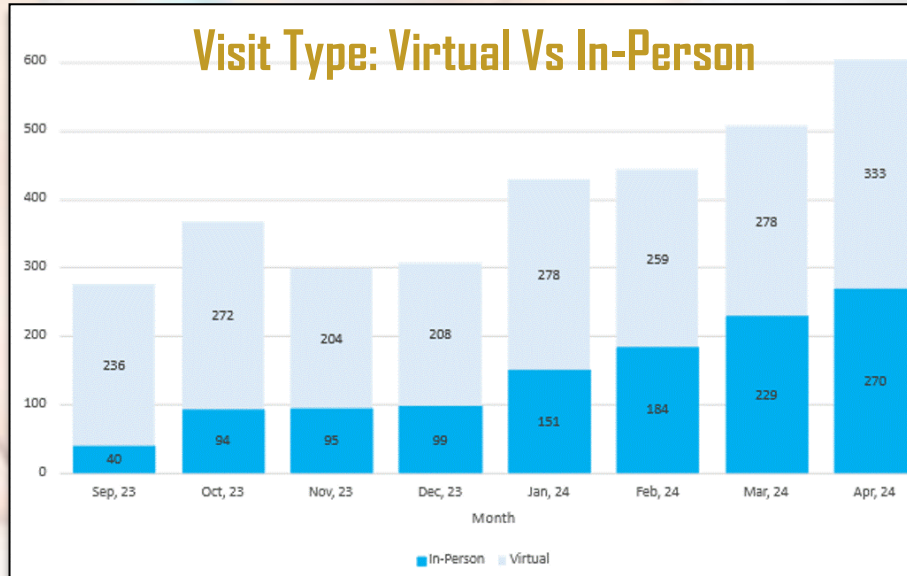
