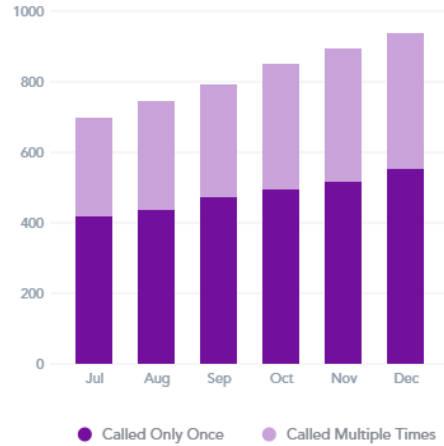

- 20 Midwifery practices

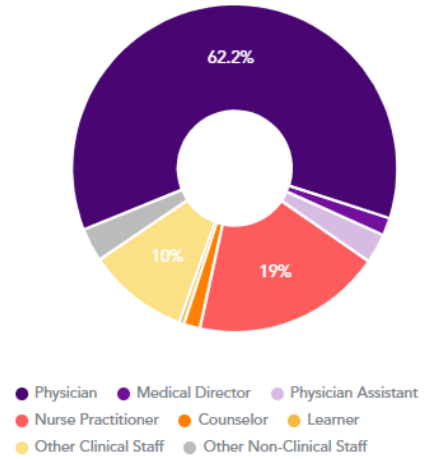


# PeriPAN: Consultation Volume & Enrollment (as of December 31, 2024)

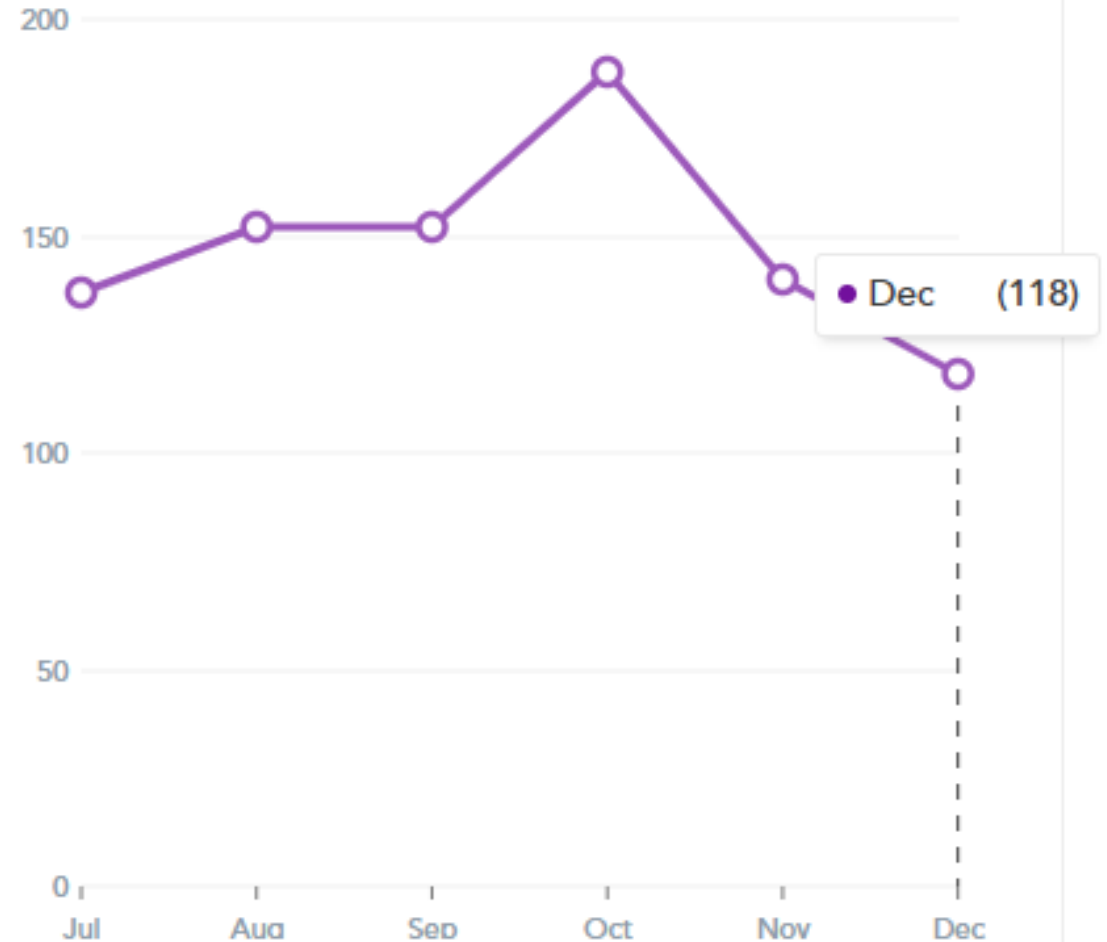
Clinic Staff Engagement



Clinic Staff Roles

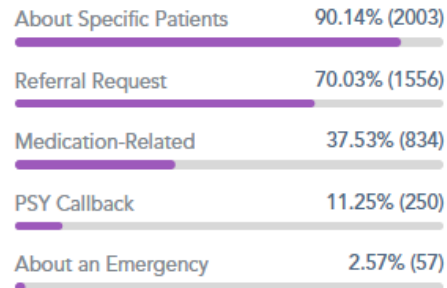


Monthly Consult Volume

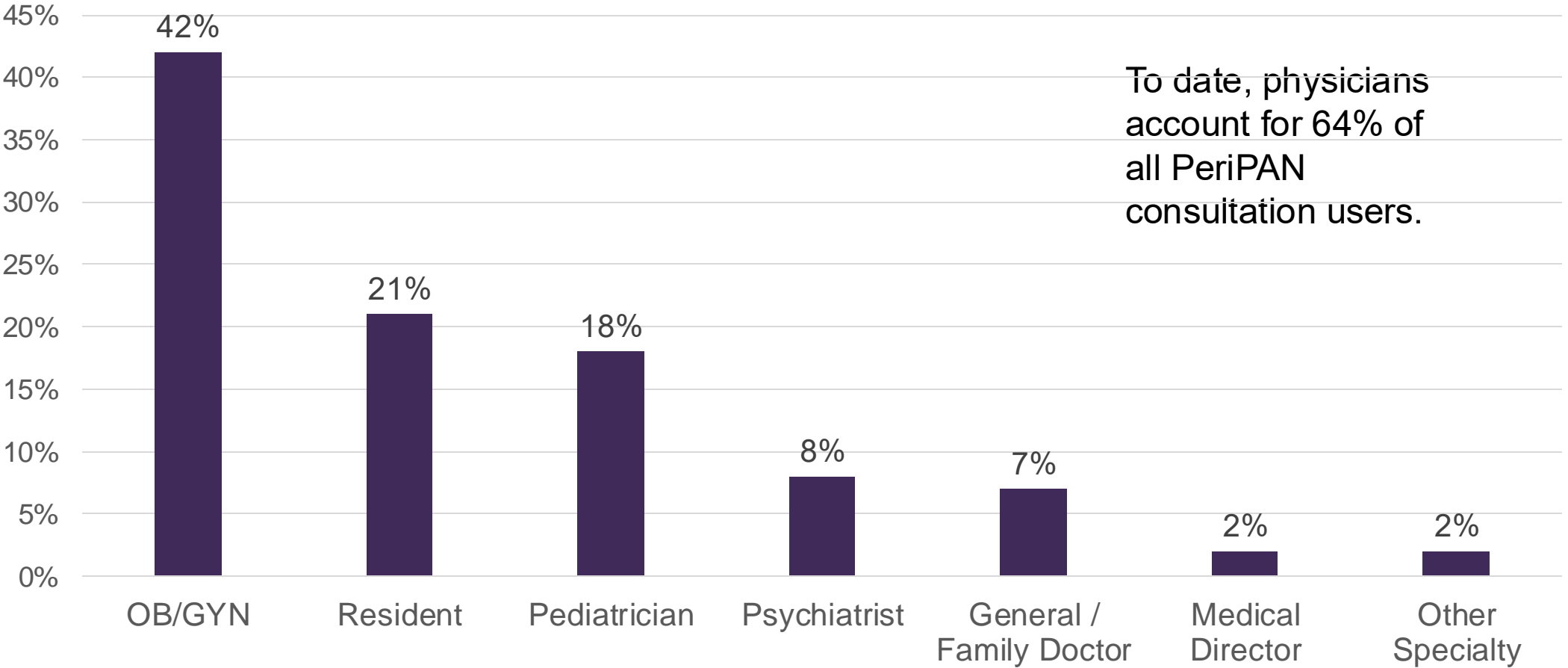

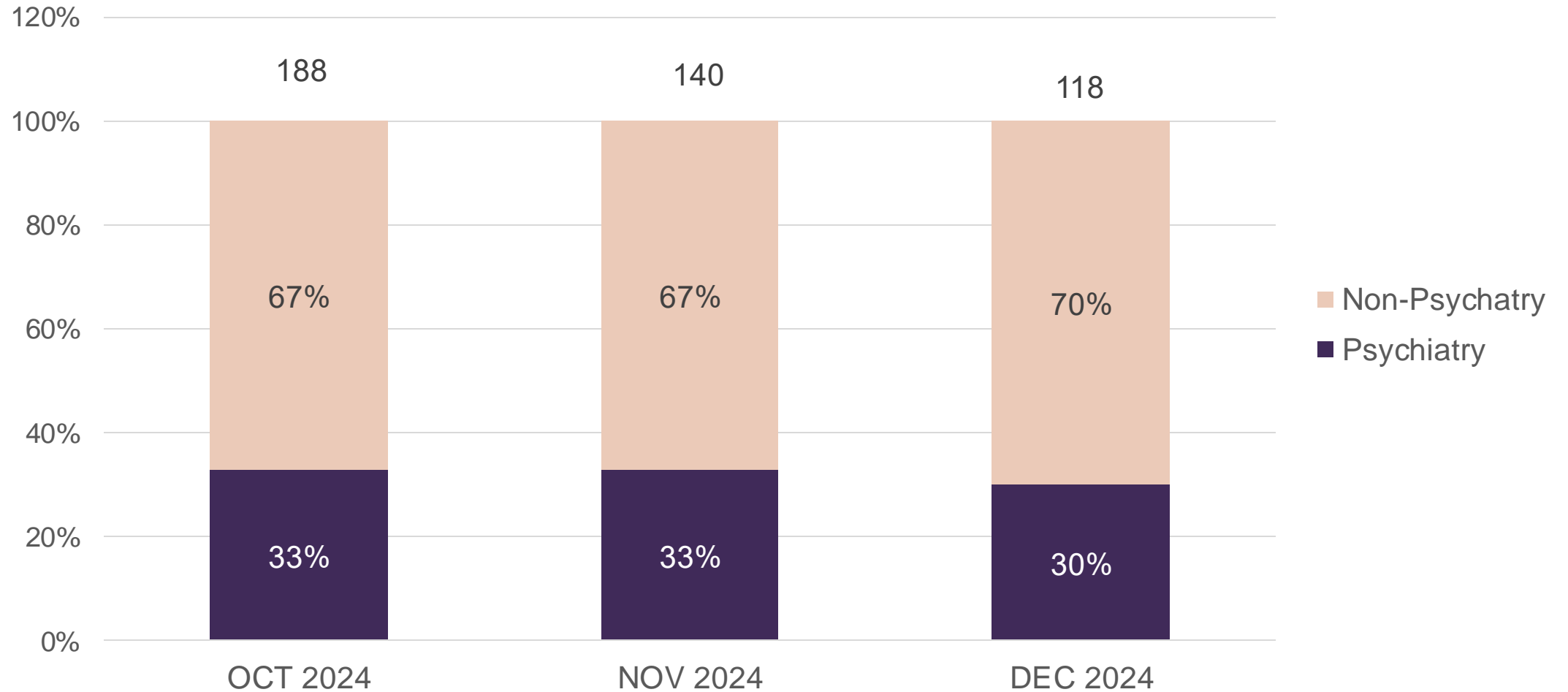


# Percent of Unique Physician PeriPAN Users by Physician Type

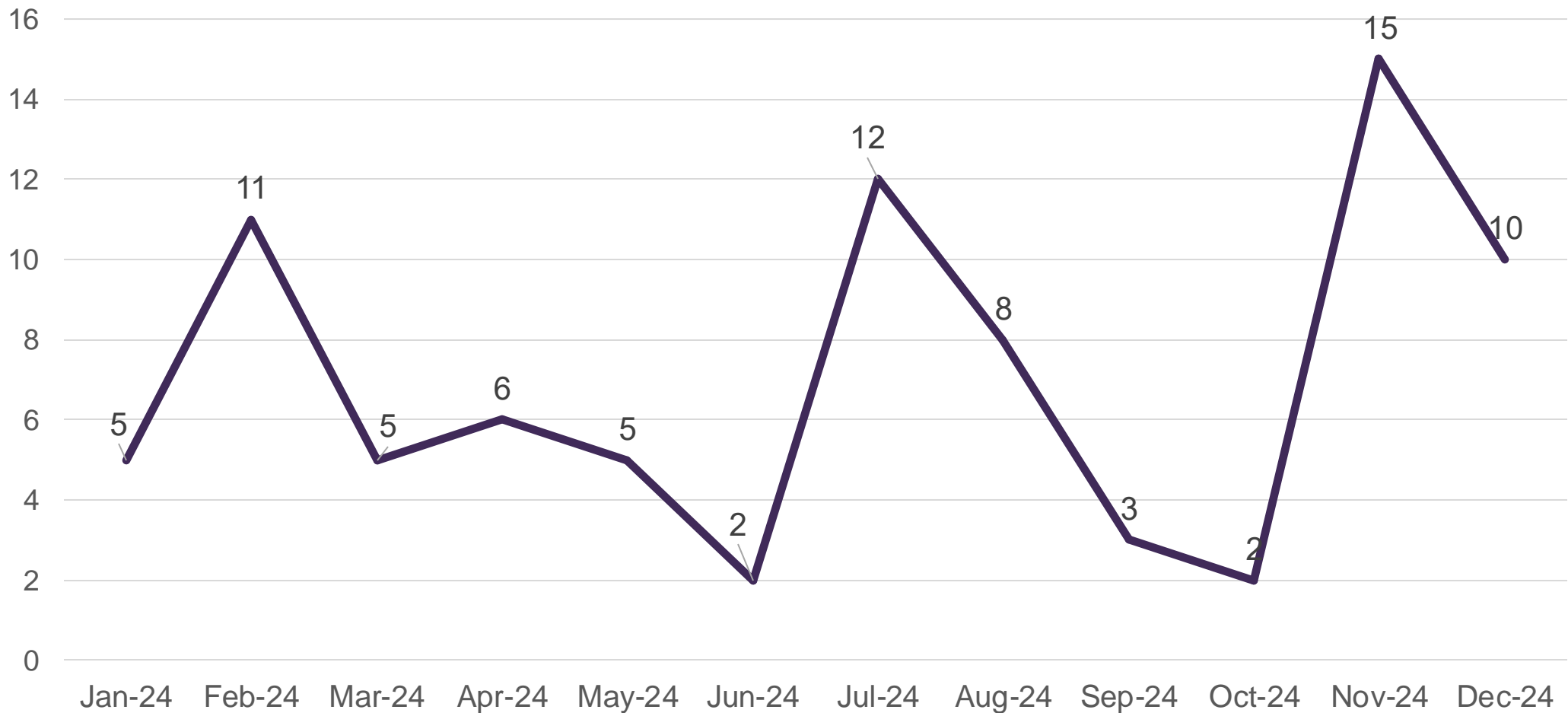
