

### PeriPAN: Consultation Volume & Enrollment (as of February 28, 2025)










### Percent of Unique Physician PeriPAN Users by Physician Type as of February 28, 2025






## PeriPAN Consultations by Type (Psychiatry & Non-Psychiatry), December 2024 - February 2025





## CPAN Consultation Volume & Enrollment as of February 28, 2025




## CPAN Consultations by Month and Year as of February 28, 2025




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## CPAN Consultations by Type (Psychiatry & Non-Psychiatry), December 2024 – February 2025





### CPAN Direct Patient Consultations by Month as of February 28, 2025









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
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


#### Number of Treatment Sessions and Clients Served by Month as of 2/28/2025
