Scope of Research

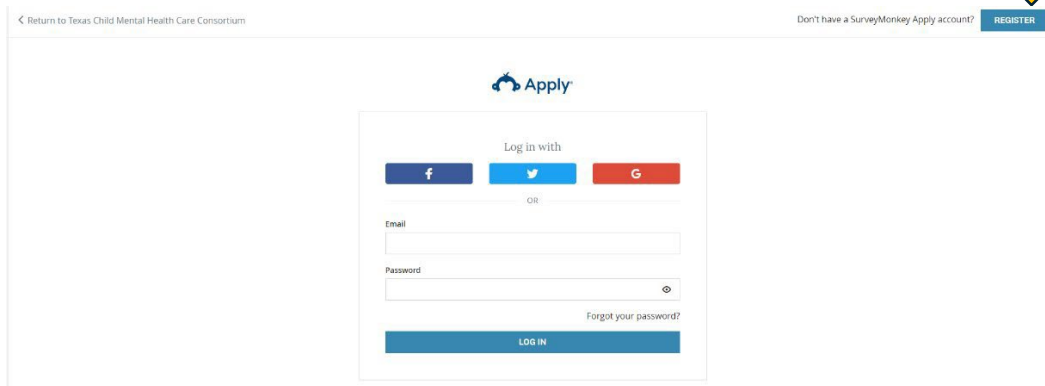
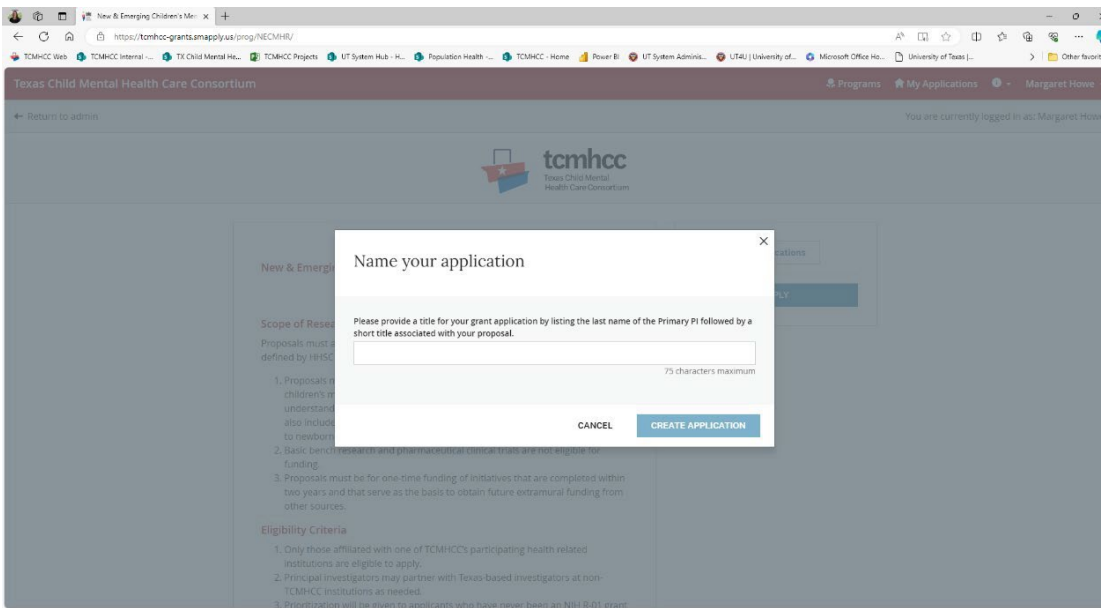
Proposals must align with the work of the TCMHCC or with state research priorities defined in the NOFO.

Proposals must focus on improving the children's mental health system and/or children's mental health services in Texas. This may include gaining an understanding of the causes of childhood psychiatric disorders. Proposals can also include perinatal research that clearly indicates and outlines the benefits to newborn and child health and wellbeing. Basic bench research and pharmaceutical clinical trials are NOT eligible for funding. Proposals must be for one-time funding of initiatives that are completed within two years and that serve as the basis to obtain future extramural funding from other sources.

Creating Your Application

If you click on the Apply button, it will ask you to provide a name for your application, then take you to the login screen. If you haven't registered yet, you can also Register from this screen by clicking on the Register button in the upper right-hand corner.



After you've created your application by submitting a name, and either logged in or registered for a new account, you will be taken to the screen below where you must click on the Eligibility Check task to start the process. This is also where you can add Collaborators if you'd like to work on the application with others.

After you answer the questions provided, you must click the Mark as Complete button at the bottom to move to the next step.

NOTE: If you do not meet eligibility criteria and you submit your application at this stage, your application will be marked Not Eligible and no further options will be provided to you.
